The Future Generations Commissioner

- Promote the sustainable development principle
 - Act as a Guardian for the interests of Future Generations in Wales
 - Encourage public bodies to take greater account of the long term impact of the things that they do
- Advise, encourage and promote
- Research
- Carry out reviews
- Make recommendations
- Future Generations Report
- Advisory Panel

The Auditor General for Wales

May carry out examinations of the public bodies listed in the Act to assess:

....the extent to which a body **has acted in accordance with the sustainable development principle** when;

a) setting well-being objectives,

and

b) taking steps to meet those objectives
